A "SAFETY" AIRPLANE Machine Intended to Land Safely With All Controls

EXPERIMENTING WITH

(London Daily Mail and Cross Atlantic News Service.)

Paris, Nov. 4.—Mesers. Morane and Saulnier. Airplane manufacturers, announce their intention of experimenting at Villacoublay, near Paris, with an airplane, which will start, fly and land with locked controls.

"An airplane," M. Morane says, "is made to fly, and should always fly level and come down normally without any use of the controls which should be for directing the machine's course orly."

"The object of the experiments will be to show that in case of accident to the pilot in the air the machine can always land safely, if it is over an aerodrome or level ground, and if the pilot has time to cut off the engine.

NO HITCH IN PLANS FOR B. E. STEEL MERGER

Toronto, Nov. 4.—A financier in close touch with the merger of the British Empire Steel Corporation is quoted as saying that no hitch has occurred in the plans, that arrangements are proceeding as rapidly as possible. Matters are now in the hands of the lawyers, of whom about ten are working on the merger. Laws and regulations of several different Canadian provinces have to be reconciled and along with that are the legal conditions in Empland from which some of the capital will be derived.
