IX. And be it enacted, That the lands or grounds Land may be which may be taken without the consent of the proprie-taken without consent 33 tors thereof, for the use of such intended Railway, and yards wide. the ditches, drains and fences to separate the same from 10 the adjoining lands, shall not exceed thirty-three yards in breadth: Provided always, that in the places where the For cuttings said intended Railway shall be raised higher, or cut more and embankments or off-ments or offthan five feet deeper than the present surface of the land, sets, 150 and in the places where it shall be judged necessary to yards. 15 have off-sets for the locomotives or other engines and carriages using the said intended Railway, there may be so taken a total breadth of one hundred and fifty yards: and provided always, that when any houses, For stations ware-houses, toll-houses, watch-houses, weighing-beams, 300 yards by 20 cranes, fixed engines, or inclined planes, may be purposed to be erected, or goods, wares or merchandize to be delivered, there may be so taken a total extent of not more than three hundred yards in length, by two hundred and fifty yards in breadth, without the consent of the

25 proprietors.

X. And be it enacted, That after any lands or grounds All bodies shall be net out and ascertained in manner aforesaid, for politic. &c. may sell, &c. making and completing the said Railway and other works, to the Comand other the purposes and conveniences hereinbefore pany. 30 mentioned, it shall and may be lawful for all bodies politic, corporate, or collegiate, corporation aggregate or sole, communities, guardians, curators, executors, administrators, and all other trustees or persons whatsoever, not only for and on behalf of themselves, their heirs and 35 successors, but also for and on behalf of those whom they represent, whether infants, issue unborn, lunatics, idiots, femmes convertes, or other person or persons who are or shall be seized, possessed of or interested in any lands or grounds which shall be so set out and ascertained as 40 aforesaid, or any part thereof, to contract for, sell and convey unto the said Company of Proprietors, their successors or assigne, all or any part of such lands or grounds which shall from time to time be set out and ascertained as aforesaid; and that all contracts, agreements, sales, 45 conveyances and assurances so to be made, shall be valid and effectual in law to all intents and purposes whatsoever, any law, statute, usage or custom to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding; and all bodies politic, corporate or collegiate, or communities, and all persons 50 whatsoever so conveying as aforesaid, are hereby indemnified for what he, she, or they, or any of them shall respectively do, by virtue of or in pursuance of this Act;
