

XXIX. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons occupying or possessing any enclosed lands near any toll-house or toll-gates which shall be erected in pursuance of this Act, shall knowingly permit or suffer
 5 any person or persons to pass through such lands, or through any gate, passage or way thereon, with any carriage or animal liable to the payment of toll, whereby such payment shall be avoided, every person or persons so offending, and also the person riding or driving any
 10 animal or carriage whereon such payment is avoided, being thereof convicted before any one Justice as aforesaid, shall, for every such offence, severally incur a penalty not exceeding shillings, which shall be
 laid out in improving such road.

Penalty for assisting others to evade payment of tolls.

XXX. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for any municipal body corporate, having jurisdiction within the locality through which any such Road shall pass, or in which any such work as aforesaid is to be constructed, to subscribe for, acquire, accept and hold, and to depart with
 20 and transfer, stock in any Company to be formed under the authority of this Act, and from time to time to direct the Mayor, or other chief officer thereof, on behalf of such Municipality, to subscribe for such stock in the name of such Municipality, and to act for and on behalf of such
 25 Municipality in all matters relative to such stock and the exercise of the rights of such Municipality as a Stockholder, and the Mayor, or other chief officer shall, whether otherwise qualified or not, be deemed a Stockholder in the Company, and may vote and act as such, subject
 30 always to such rules and orders in relation to his authority as shall be made in that behalf by such Municipality by their By-laws or otherwise, but acting according to his discretion in cases not provided for by such Municipality; and it shall be lawful for such Municipality to pay for, or
 35 to pay all instalments upon the stock they shall subscribe for and acquire, out of any moneys belonging to such Municipality and not specially appropriated to any other purpose, and to apply the moneys arising from the dividends or profits on the said stock or from the sale thereof,
 40 to any purpose to which unappropriated moneys belonging to such Municipality may lawfully be applied.

Municipalities may take stock in any such Company.

XXXI. And be it enacted, That it shall also be lawful for the Municipality of any locality through which any such Road shall pass, or within which any such work as
 45 aforesaid shall be constructed, to loan money to the Company authorized to make such Road or construct such work, out of any moneys belonging to the Municipality and not appropriated to any other purpose, and to effect such loan upon such terms and conditions as may be
 50 agreed upon between such Company and the Municipality making such loan, and to recover the money so

Municipalities may lend money to any such Company.
