3. For the purpose of raising such sum as aforesaid, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to authorize the sale of Provincial Stock, or the issuing of Debentures, or both, to an amount not exceeding in the whole the sum last aforesaid ; and any Debentures so to be issued may be in such form, for such separate sums, at such rate of interest not exceeding five per centum per annum, and the principal and interest thereon may be made payable at such periods and at such places, as to the Governor in Council shall seem most expedient, the said principal and interest being hereby made chargeable upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province. 5 10

Toronto Gaol.

4. The sum of eighteen thousand dollars appropriated in the Schedule hereunto annexed for the Toronto Gaol, shall be taken out of and charged upon the Upper Canada Building Fund ; and 15

Quebec Gaol.

The sum of fifteen thousand five hundred dollars appropriated in the said Schedule for the completion of the Quebec Gaol, shall be taken out of and charged upon the Building and Jury Fund for the District of Quebec, and

Kamouraska
Gaol, &c.

The sum of four thousand dollars appropriated in the said Schedule for repairing the Kamouraska Gaol and Court House, shall be taken out of and charged upon the Building and Jury Fund for the District of Kamouraska. 20

Accounts to be
laid before
Parliament.

5. Accounts in detail of all moneys raised, received and paid under this Act, and of the Provincial Stock or Debentures sold or issued under the same, and of the interest thereon, and of the redemption of the whole for any part thereof, and of all expenses attending the raising and payment of the sums to be raised, received and paid under this Act, shall be laid before both Houses of the Legislature of this Province, at each Session thereof. 25 30
