shall have the seal of the Municipality affixed thereto and the said License shall be subject to all By-Laws, rules and regulations which are now or hereafter may be in force in said Municipality respecting the same or trade business or calling Licensed thereby, and any application for a License may be in form "B" of this By-Law and all applications for a License shall be made to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Municipality and shall be accompanied by the proper fee therefore.

12. Any person found guilty of a breach of this By-Law shall upon conviction by a Justice of the Peace or other Officer having jurisdiction, be liable to the penalties imposed by the By-Law providing for the enforcement of the By-Laws of the Rural Municipality of Coldwell.
