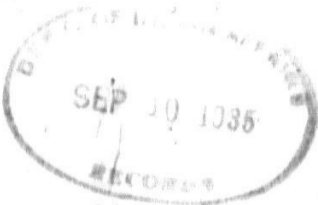



Sir,

With reference to your letter No. 27107-3 dated August 22nd. enclosing a letter from Mr. Jules Ed. Savard of Shell River Sask.

About a year ago Mr Savard built a house on which he thought was the road allowance, but was about 7feet on the reserve. This summer the Indians complained, and I instructed the Farm Instructor, Mr Burch to go over, and ask him to remove the house, but he neglected to do so. About three weeks ago the chief saw him, and ordered him to move. How-ever as it is late in the season, and this man is not giving any trouble I see no harm in him remaining till next spring.
