

lands or conflict with or embarrass or in any manner whatsoever occasion any private or public damage, nuisance or inconvenience.

4. THAT the permittee shall at the expiration or sooner determination of the term of this permit quietly and peacefully vacate and surrender the hereinbefore described lands together with his permit and all interest therein.

5. In case of default by the permittee in the due observance or compliance with any of the terms or conditions of this permit or the regulations governing the issue thereof the Minister may in his discretion cancel this permit or any portion thereof and the same shall be declared null and void as the Minister may decide.
