Provision for Representatives of the  
Churches of Canada at the Coronation  
Ceremony in Westminster Abbey

The list of guests invited to the Coronation Ceremony at Westminster Abbey June 22, 1911, includes, as I mentioned this morning, the international head of the Salvation Army. His name appears as Bramwell Booth. I am not sufficiently familiar with the names of the representative heads of the three Churches of the United Kingdom in 1911 to identify them in the list, but it is a safe assumption that they would be invited guests in view of the fact that the head of the Salvation Army was included. For example, there are the names The Reverend Wesley Guard, the Reverend Eugene Smirnoff, the Most Reverend the Primus of the Scottish Episcopal Church, the Right Reverend Monsignor Eugenio Pacelli, and quite a number of other "The Reverends", "Very Reverends" and "Right Reverends".

Other Names

In addition to the names that can be readily identified as those of members of the Peerage, the Diplomatic Corps, Foreign Royalties, Indian Princes, Church of England Dignitaries, the Judiciary, United Kingdom and Dominion Privy Councillors and Parliamentarians, there is a large number of Mayors of United Kingdom Cities and Towns and I see the names of the Mayor of Adelaide (Lewis Cohen), the Mayor of Toronto (George R. Geary), the Mayor of Montreal, (Dr. J. J. Guerin) and F. C. Wade.
