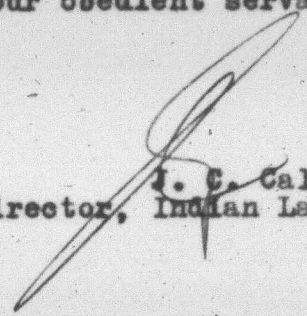
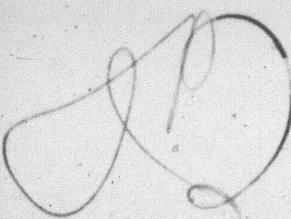

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, dealing with the above matter.
