Sir,-

The Department has received from the Canadian Bank of Commerce, Pincher Creek a voucher rendered at \$463.00 which you issued in favour of Mr. W. O. Weymark, which voucher was cashed at the Bank. In handing the voucher to Mr. Weymark to be cashed, you departed from the regular course. You should not again take such action, except in the case of voucher issued for postage stamps.
