As it is on the world-wide stage, so it is in each national community. The way of privilege, of monopoly, of unrestricted power is the way of desolation, destruction and death.

The road to victory for the common man is the road of equality, of co-operation, of brotherhood among men.

Just as a partnership of the warriors and the workers is essential to victory in war, so is a partnership of workers on the farm, in the forest, in the mine, in the factory and the shop, of workers with hand and with brain, for the common weal, essential to the building of a new society in which the old but threatened freedoms: religious, political and personal, will be joined to the new freedom which will banish fear and want from men.

That is the victory for which we must fight and work. Nothing less can give us the will to bear the burdens, to accept the hardships and to make the effort which are required to place our feet firmly on the highway to a better future at this crossroads of humanity.
