I am A/Capt. W. Snell, Company Commander,

the 18 Oct 44 at approximately 1400 hrs
I paraded personnel of my Coy. in my
office to sign a draft warning
as they were proceeding forward. I read
the draft warning to them and explained
its meaning and asked if there
were any questions. O. 22078, Pte
Bradbury P.F. was on this parade
and stated that he knew what he
was signing and that he would be
C.B. from that time. He then signed
the draft warning. I submit the

signature. At 2200 hrs 18 October 44 Pte
Bradbury P.F. was absent and was still
