WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued to Wednesday, the Second day of October, instant:

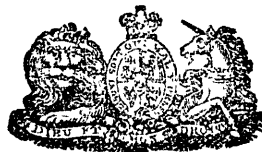
