## CAP. X:

An ACT for granting to Her Majesty certain Supplies for the Civil Government of this Colony, and other purposes.

[Passed 29th April, 1840.]

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY,

VV E, Your Majesty's dutiful and loyal subjects the Commons of Preamble. Newfoundland, having freely and voluntarily resolved to give and grant unto Your Majesty a Supply to defray certain charges for the support of the Civil Government, for the Administration of Justice, and other purposes, do humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and-

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, Sum of £799 17s, that it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, by Warrant under Id. appropriated for this hand and seal, to draw from and out of the Treasury the Sum of Act. Seven Candred and Ninety-nine Pounds Seventeen Shillings and One Penny, to defray the following charges and expenses, that is

The sum of Four Hundred Pounds, to meet Gaol expenses for the Gaol expenses Year ending the 30th day of June, One Thousand Eight Hundred £400. and Forty.

The sum of One Hundred and Forty-nine Pounds Seventeen Shil- support of Paupers lings and One Penny, to defray the expenses of supporting Paupers in £149 17s. 1d. the Hospital of St. John's.

And a further sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds, to defray the Crown Prosecutions expenses of Civil and Criminal Prosecutions to the Thirtieth of June, £250. One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-one.
