

**Weak Points in the Militia.**

OTTAWA, Ont., December 28.—Major-General Herbert has issued his annual report on the training of the militia, and considers that the commanding officers have taken advantage of the long notice given them there would have been larger numbers at the camps. He is severe on quartermasters and warns them that in future they will be dealt with if they do not report at camp a day ahead of their battalions. He criticizes the style of horses hired for cavalry service and gives a much needed lesson from a soldier's point of view. He says too great importance cannot be attached to the proper performance of staff duties. In camps of rural military every staff officer from the Major-General commanding downwards must remember that he is before every thing an instructor in those duties which fall under his personal supervision. It is not sufficient for staff officers to issue orders. They must see that those orders are carried out, and that reasonable means exist for carrying them out.

**Supposed Suicide in Ottawa.**

OTTAWA, Dec. 28.—Mrs. Labelle, wife of a hawthorn operator in the Printing Bureau, was found dead early this morning under suspicious circumstances. The body lay in bed, and in a perfectly nude condition. There were marks of violence on the arms and legs. Her mouth and limbs were bound severely with carbolic acid, whilst a half filled bottle of whiskey was found in her bedroom. An inquest was held tonight, at which the woman's mother and several neighbors testified that the quarrels between Labelle and his wife were so serious that the latter had to be taken home. No verdict was rendered, but the general impression is that the woman committed suicide as the result of domestic troubles.
