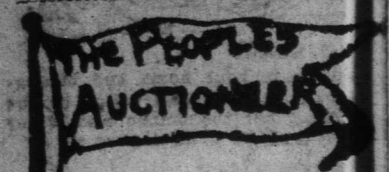

Specifications and plans of the works required may be seen at the Office of Marine and Fisheries at any time by persons who intend submitting tenders, and "Form of Tender" may be obtained from the said office on application.
