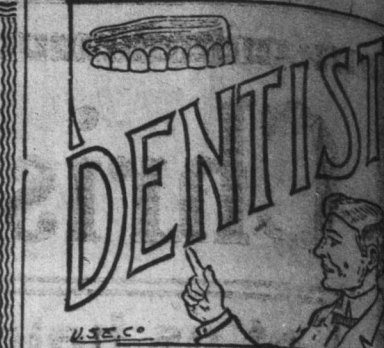

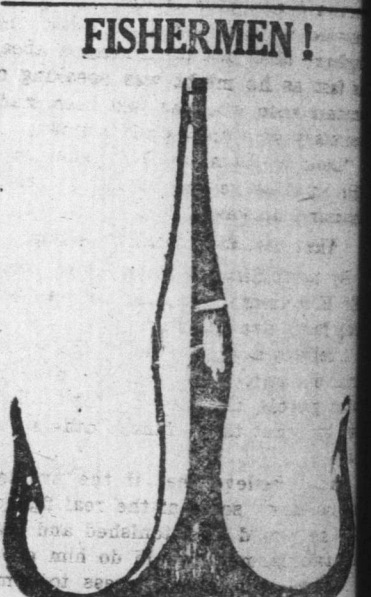

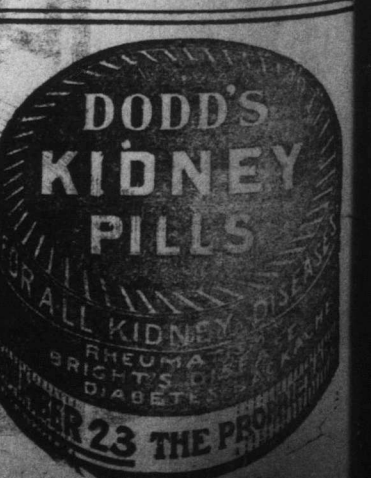

## Household Notes.

Marshmallows coated with a fudge mixture are a novel kind of fudge. Rice pudding baked in cups is good with chopped nuts sprinkled over it. The simplest way to have flowers in winter is to choose those that grow in water.

Salads should have an indispensable part in the well-balanced ration especially in winter.

Time is saved by having a glass measuring cup in both flour bin and sugar bin.

Most important in the making of good coffee is to use the water at the first boil.

To be successful in canning fruit one should sterilize as carefully as a surgeon does.

A small iron frying pan, such as is used for omelets, is best for frying pancakes.

People who do not like steamed rice will eat it with a curry powder or gravy addition.

Do not allow the drain pipe of your refrigerator to become clogged. Woolen vests and sweaters should be reshaped frequently while drying. Any soup except a cream soup can easily be reheated for a second day. Whipped cream used for desserts should be flavored before being whipped.

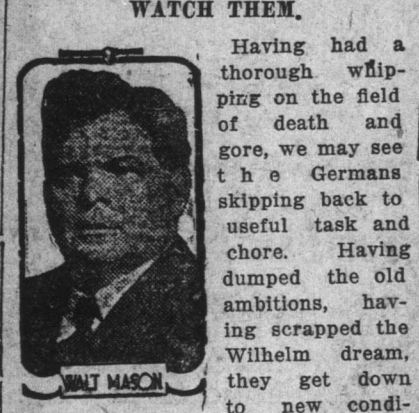
