We have altered our title, and have added to it the word: CANADIANA, which needs no explanation. The scope of our review will now comprehend all matters pertaining to the history of Canada. We will have contributors in both languages, and communications are hereby cheerfully solicited from all those interested with matters of history. Our bibliographical bulletin will contain, as before, a review of the principal publications of the preceding month, Canadian, American and European.

The Transactions and Historical Manuscript series of the Literary and Historical Society of Quebec will be first published in Le Courrier du Livre, and afterwards set up in pamphlet form.

We hope that all those who favored our enterprise up to date will continue to patronise it as in the past, and that this happy combination will bring us a good many new subscribers.
