

PARSNIPS, BAKED.—Scrape and wash them nicely, and if large, divide them. Parboil them in water, or milk and water. Take a baking dish, and therein place several pieces of butter, each the size of a walnut. Put the parsnips in the tin, which must be set in the oven. Bake till tender, and serve with melted butter or good beel gravy.

BARED INDIAN PUDDING—One quart sweet milk, one ounce butter, four well-beaten eggs, one teacupful corn meal, quarter of a pound of sugar, half a cup of molasses. Scald the milk, and stir in meal while boiling; let stand till lukewarm; stir well' together. Bake one and a half hours; serve with or without sauce. Half a pound of raisins may be added if desired.
