THE BOSTON MARKET.

Spruce lumber seems to be a little firmer at Boston, with the domaid rather better and less desire on the part of manufacturers to erge business. The low grade randoms that have recently hung over the market have manny been worked off. Quotations are firm : Ten and 12-inch dimensions, \$20 to \$21, 9-inch and under, \$19 to \$20; to and 12 inch, random lengths, 10 feet and up, \$20.50; 2x3, 2x4, 2x5, 2x6, 2x7, and 3x4, to feet and up, \$17 to \$17.501 all other endons ginch and under to feet and up, \$16.50 to \$18; 5-inch and up, merchantable boards, \$17; matched boards, \$19 to \$20; out spruce boards, \$13.50 to \$14; bundle furring, \$17 to \$18.

Hemlock lumber is steady, with offerings small: Boards, 12, 14 and 16 feet stock, \$15 to \$15.50 for good eastern; Pennsylvania, No. 1, \$16 to \$17.50 . No. 2, \$15 10 \$15.50.

White pine is even firmer and higher, with quotations advanced: Uppers, 1-m. to 2 in. \$82.50 to \$85; 21/2 to 3 in. \$87 to \$ " ; 4·in, \$90 ; selects, 1 in, \$/8 ; 11 to 134 in. \$70; 2 in. \$72; 23/2 to 3 in. \$80; 4 m. \$82; fine common, 1-m. \$62 to \$63; 114 to 11/2 in. \$65; 2-in. \$67.50; 21/2 and 3 in. \$72. 0; 4-in. \$82.50; barn boards, \$23 to \$33; coffin boards, \$28 to \$32.
