Besides these there are: One BREWSTER Exhibition (\$50); Three STEVENSON Science Scholarships (\$24); One McCAWLEY Hebrew Prize (\$36); One Cogswell Scholarship (\$120), open for Candidates for Holy Orders; One McCAWLEY Testimonial Scholarship (\$28); One ALEXIS Historical Prize (\$20); One ALMON WELFORD Testimonial (\$24); One HARRINGTON Prize (\$20); One Cogswell Cricket prize. The necessary expenses of Board, Rooms, &c., average \$15 per annum. Nominated students do not pay tuition fees. These nominations fifty in number, are open to all Matriculated Students, and are worth about \$80 for the three years course. All Matriculated Students are required to reside in College unless specially exempted. The Professor's reside within the limits of the University grounds.
