

SELECTED BIBLIOGRAPHY

Throughout the text there are references to numerous editorials and other articles in newspapers, magazines and journals of opinion, and to some books. From this selected bibliography are excluded newspaper articles, and published material in which references to Latin America are brief, or are related mainly to specific recent events. Included are books, articles, etc., dealing in a general way with Canada's relations with Latin America, or with the Organization of American States.

It will be noted that the material listed in the bibliography is almost entirely in English. There are two main reasons for the absence of French titles, as follows:

- a) In the course of the study no French-language books dealing wholly or partly with Canada's relations with Latin America were found; and
- b) There appears to be a tendency for writers in French to include discussion of matters of long-term interest in newspaper articles dealing primarily with recent events, references to which are to be found throughout the text, whereas writers in English tend to discuss matters of long-term interest in books and in articles that are published in university and other periodicals that are readily accessible.

It should be noted that a useful list of editorials and editorial notes on Latin America that appeared in four leading French-language newspapers from 1959 to 1973 is to be found in Etudes Internationales, Vol. VII, No. 3, September 1976. (See entry in bibliography under the name of Gay, Daniel.)
