QUESTION:

Would it be possible at any point for a united Germany within MATO to have any kind of Soviet or Warsew Treaty troops in the Mastern portion?

POWEIGH SECRETARY:

You do have at the moment a large number of Soviet troops in the GDE and clearly one of the questions to be addressed, one of the questions in which the Soviet Union has a clear interest, is what the future arrangements for those should be.

QUESTICS (Olivia Ward, Toronto Star):

To follow up on that question, how would the future of a EATO united Germany affect current negotiations on troop withdrawnls and troop etrength in Europe?

PORRIGE SECRETARY:

I do not think they would. I muntioned manpower, we have now CFE discussions covering manpower levels. We believe that the relatively new American proposals are a correct Western move, as it were, in those negotiations and I do not think there is an intimate connection between that and the German question we are now considering.
