I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your Note of January 26, 1951, in which you inform me that the Government of Canada proposes to conclude with the Government of India an agreement regarding the entry of citizens of India to Canada for permanent residence.

The provision set forth in your Note under reference are acceptable to the Government of India and I am authorized to confirm that your Note and this reply constitute an agreement between the two Governments which may be terminated by either Government on giving six months' notice.
