• The architectural societies of Canada and the U.S. have established criteria that will recognize the qualifications of architects from each other's country.

Mr. Wilson and Ambassador Hills also discussed a number of outstanding trade issues and noted the importance of the FTA in helping to resolve bilateral issues.

They added that the FTA is helping to achieve the trade and economic objectives in both countries and that it complements and reinforces other international trade agreements and negotiations.
