PRAYERS.

Mr. Fournier (Hull), a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, presented,—Return to an Order of the House of June 25, 1952, for a copy of all correspondence, telegrams, reports, petitions and surveys, from 1949 to date, relating to the dredging of the harbour at Tracadie, in the County of Gloucester, New Brunswick, and the construction of adequate breakwaters for the protection of said harbour.

And also,—Return to an Order of the House of June 30, 1952, for a copy of the pay-rolls and lists of materials purchased in connection with the construction of a wharf at Bellerive, County of Labelle, during the fall of 1951.

Mr. McCubbin, Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Agriculture, presented,—Return to an Order of the House of May 14, 1952, for a copy of all correspondence received by the Minister, or the Deputy Minister, or any of the officials of the Department of Agriculture, from or on behalf of owners of cattle slaughtered in the campaign for the eradication of foot-and-mouth disease in the Province of Saskatchewan, approving or complaining about the settlements that have been made for such cattle.
