ESTABLISHMENT OF DEEP SEA PORT IN PRINCE RUPERT,

Question No. 1,073—**Mr. Oberle:**

What commitment and contractual arrangements has the government entered into with contractors or local governments and what plans are being worked out in respect to the establishment of a deep sea port in Prince Rupert, B.C.?

Hon. Jean Marchand (Minister of Transport): The National Harbours Board advises as follows: NHB has no commitment and contractual arrangements with contractors or local governments. NHB proposes the construction of a deep sea dock facility comprising some 42 acres at the Fairview site at Prince Rupert. DPW has now completed first stage design and specifications and NHB proposes to call for tenders this spring.
