*Mr. Laing*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. What was the tonnage and value of Canadian imports from the United States of elemental sulphur, in each of the years 1945 to 1951?

2. What is the capacity in tons of Canadian construction already completed or announced for the production of elemental sulphur?

*Mr. Gagnon*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. Who is in charge of placing and removing of buoys in the Saguenay River?

2. What amount is paid for this work and what is the term of the contract?

*Mr. Wright*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. Has the government entered into any agreement or arrangement to purchase boneless canned beef from Canadian packers?

2. If so, what are the terms and amounts covered by any such agreement?
