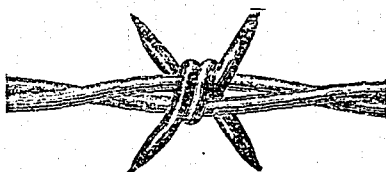

It is cheaper than boards or rail fences. 2nd—No cattle, however unruly, can pass it. 3rd—It is steel, and of two strands, and cannot be broken. 4th—It can be put up with the same ease as the old plain wire. 5th—It cannot be burned; it is proof against wind, fire or flood, and prevents snow drifts. 6th—It is a steel thorn hedge, and does not furnish a good rail to sit on. Defects of plain wire as a material for fencing: 1st—Liability to break, being but one strand. 2nd—Attitude liable to press against it, or crowd through and break it down. 3rd—Being but one strand, it has no power of adapting itself to changes of temperature, and is therefore constantly breaking.
