

CHOICE BUTCHERS' VALUES ARE FIRM

Small Percentage of Offerings at Stock Yards Was of This Class.

LAMB MARKET IS HIGH

Best Quality Fifteen Cents Higher and Light Sheep Up Twenty-Five Cents.

The receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards on Tuesday numbered 75 cars, including 1263 cattle, 160 calves, 991 hogs, 611 sheep and 1000 lambs. Butchers' cattle: Steers and heifers to all were a very small percentage of the receipts yesterday and values were firm. Choice butchers' steers of 1100 to 1200 lbs. sold from \$7.50 to \$7.75 and one car of choice heifers, 950 lbs., went at \$7.25. A few medium to good steers sold at \$6.50 to \$6.75. Cows were in the majority in the consignments and sold actively at steady prices for common and fair canner kinds, with a firm tone among the good to choice fat grades. Canner prices are \$3.50 to \$3.75; common cows around \$4.50; medium cows about \$5.00; good at \$5.75; up to choice at \$6.25 to \$6.50. Stockers and feeders: Yearling steers of good quality are up 25c above last week and the choice ones are selling at \$6.25 to \$6.50. Outside of this class and choice heavy feeders the trading is quiet. Rice and Whaley sold 55 stock steers, light eastern \$4 to \$4.50 and fair to good steers at \$3.50 to \$3.75. Lambs and sheep: Firm and unchanged. Dunn and Levack sold 100 good cows at \$4 to \$4.50 each. Dealers are very active in this division. The market is active at high-water level and good lambs and light sheep are 15c to 20c higher than last week. Heavy lambs are quoted at \$9 to \$9.25 and light lambs at \$8.50 to \$8.75.
