Saturday, June 24th, 1775. The Address, Petition and Memorial to his Majesty and both houses of Parliament, was read and agreed to by the house with amendments.

Ordered, That three copies thereof, and duplicates be immediately ingrofs'd, and that Mr. Speaker, Mr. Tonge, Mr. Day, and Mr. Dechampe, do examine and compare the fame.

Ordered, That Mr. Speaker, do fign the faid addresses in behalf of this house, and without delay transmit one of them to the Right Honorable the Earl of Dartmouth to be presented to his Majesty, another to the Right Honorable the Lord Chancelsor to be laid before the House of Lords, and another to the Right Honorable the Speaker of the House of Commons to be laid before that Honorable House.
