The tops, limbs, and stumps left to rot by lumberers are vast nurseries of insects, which are sending forth ever increasing armies which, if not arrested, will in a few years destroy the young coniferous forests of New Brunswick. The only check to the multiplication of these pests is to burn all stumps, tops, brush, and injured trees each year, wherever man destroys the forest.
