



Montreal Jewish Women's Societies Endorse Federation Principle.

Montreal, Oct. 16—The irrevocable principle of federation against the practice of such forms of soliciting funds for charities as tag-days, bazzars, raffles, theatre-ticket selling and other demonstrations was endorsed at a meeting of the representatives of the Jewish Women's societies, who met at the campaign headquarters of the Federation of Jewish Philanthropies to consider ways and means of helping the "Save the Federation" campaign that will take place October 22-26.

As a result of the meeting there will be an effort made by the societies to enroll 1,500 Jewish women as annual members of the Federation. The societies that have pledged their energy to achieve this end are as follows:

The Montreal Council of Jewish Women, the Hebrew Young Ladies' Sewing Society, the Jewish Endeavor Sewing Sochool, the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Shaar Hashomayim Synagogue, the Sisterhood, the Hadassah organization and the Grace Aguilar Chapter of the I. O. D. E.




