ZIONIST DRIVE. (Montreal Herald.) The Canadian Zionist Federation reports that more than \$60,000 has been collected to date for the Palestine Restoration Fund. All classes of the Jewish population are pledging to the captains and workers of the various teams. Every part of the city is being canvassed and the Zionist officials are confident that Montreal will raise its quota. The drive has taken on a new interest in view of the recent troubles in Palestine as the Zionists of Montreal desire to demonstrate their absolute confidence in the British government and their earnestness to obtain Palestine for the Jewish people under a British Mandate.

RECITAL AT WOLFVILLE WAS MARKED SUCCESS

Miss Ruth Blaisdell MacDonald, soprano, assisted by Miss Beryl Blaisdell, pianist, and Miss Marie Wilson, contralto, gave an excellent song recital in Acadia College hall on last Friday evening, before a large and appreciative audience. Miss MacDonald's first group was sung with fine taste. Debut Le Jour (from Louise) was a gem. The second group, "Oh, Mother, My Love," by Farley; "Oh, Didn't It Rain?" (arguably spiritual) "My Menagerie," by Foster, and a Norwegian love song by Clough Leighton, showed skillful interpretation. Following this she sang the aria, "Oh Fors E Lui," from Traviata. So successful was this that she was forced to respond to an encore and sang the waltz song from Romeo and Juliet. She has a diction which enables her to put across her message of melody and the distinctness with which she characterizes each song proves that there is a fine sympathetic temperament back of the excellent voice. The clarity of her tones is remarkable, and the same prevailed throughout her entire range of voice. Her fine and well trained voice is a pleasure of itself.

Miss Blaisdell is a talented pianist. Her playing of the Vienna Carnival Scene by Schumann showed excellent interpretation and was rendered in an artistic manner. She is also a brilliant accompanist. Add to this a charming personality, youth, and good looks and the pianist's equipment for the concert stage is about complete.

Miss Wilson sang a group of songs in a charming manner. The first two songs, "L'Eclair" and "Si mes Verses" were excellent displays of her French and the resonant beauties of her voice well. A lullaby by Hanson charmed the audience and "I'm Wearing Away" by Footes, showed the richness of the lower voice.

The Arts, My Heart is Weary (from Nadeshda), gave proof of the singer's capabilities and revealed a wide range and exceptional talent.

The three artists responded to several encores. After the recital the young artists were tendered a reception at the home of Mrs. Gordon Prescott, Summer street.
