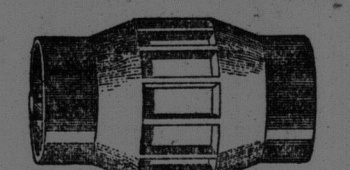
ONE CARLOAD ARRIVED
