MINUTES

OF THE

TWENTY-THIRD SESSION OF THE SYNOD

OF THE

UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA.

I. SEDERUNT.

TERONTO, MONDAY,

June 13, 1859, 7½ o'clock, P. M.

The Synod of the United Presbyterian Church in Canada met, and after sermon by the Moderator, the Rev. William Aitken, from 1 Cor. i. 17, was constituted.

The Roll of Synod, as compiled from the Rolls furnished by Roll called. Presbytery Clerks, was called and marked.

It was reported that the following changes, affecting the Roll of Synod, and the list of Probationers, had occurred since last meeting, namely:—

That the Rev. Alexander Henderson, Fitzroy Harbor, in the Presbytery of Lanark, had been removed by death, on the 23rd death. ^{taken from Roll,}

That the following ministers had demitted their charges, and that the pastoral relation with their respective congregations, ^{Demissions.}
