The accused No.L.12212 Pte. Donald Warren Hill elected trial by District Court Martial on Charge No. 1. On Charges 2, 3, 4 and 5 he was remanded by the Commanding Officer for Disposal by higher authority.

The accused, No.L.12212 Private Donald Warren Hill, The South Saskatchewan Regiment, a soldier of the Active Militia of Canada on Active Service, is charged with:-

First Charge
A.A.Sec.15(1)

Absenting himself without leave, in that he, at Weyburn, Saskatchewan, while a defaulter, absented himself from 2000 hours, March 4th, 1940, until apprehended in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan, at 2030 hours March 10th, a period of six days and thirty minutes incurring the following expenses incidental to his apprehension:-

Second Charge
A.A.Sec.9(1)

Disobeying, in such a manner as to show a wilful defiance of authority, a lawful command given personally by his Superior Officer in the execution of his office, in that he, at Weyburn, Saskatchewan, on March 12th, 1940, when ordered by Sgt. Schubert, V., South Saskatchewan Regiment, Sergeant of the Guard, to make up his bed and clean out his cell room, did not do so, and continued to lie on his bed.

Third Charge
A.A.Sec.9(1)

Disobeying, in such a manner as to show a wilful defiance of authority, a lawful command given personally by his Superior Officer in the execution of his office, in that he, at Weyburn, Saskatchewan, on March 12th, 1940, when ordered by Sgt. Harvey, A.M., South Saskatchewan Regiment, Provost Sergeant, to make up his bed and clean out his cell room, did not do so, saying "I am not going to do any more work for the army."

Fourth Charge
A.A.Sec.8(1)

Striking his Superior Officer being in the execution of his office, in that he, at Weyburn, Saskatchewan, on the 12th March, 1940, while being searched by Pte. MacAulay, F.A., South Saskatchewan Regiment, (G.M.P.) whose duty it was to do so, under the supervision of Sgt. Harvey, A.M., South Saskatchewan Regiment struck Sgt. Harvey, A.M., in the face with the fist of his right arm.

Fifth Charge
A.A.Sec.8(2)

Using threatening language to a Superior Officer in that he, at Weyburn, Saskatchewan, on March 12th, 1940, said to Sgt. Harvey, A.M., South Saskatchewan Regiment, Provost Sergeant, while being searched by Pte. MacAulay, F.A., (G.M.P.) whose duty it was to do so under the supervision of Sgt. Harvey, A.M., "I will kick your guts out if it takes me twenty years."
