PREDICT WHEAT WILL GO TO \$2 A BUSHEL

Those Holding Stocks in West Say Release of Russian Wheat would Only Temporarily Affect Values.

New York, Sept. 7.—Over-extended bull accounts in some of the prominent specialties suffered more or less depreciation in today's broad and active market, while Coppers, Petrols, Tobaccos and numerous minor issues pursued a contrary course.

Reading's strength was the outstanding feature, mounting 4 5-8 to 110 3-8. Its highest price since last May, with moderate activity and strength in other coals, New York Central, Baltimore and Ohio and New Haven.
