FOR THE YEAR 1873.

The Sub-Committee of Charity have the honor to report as follows:

Relief has been extended to ninety-two (92) persons, comprising 37 men, 16 women and 39 children.

The amount expended by the Sub-Committee is \$527.10, viz:—
