Bank Buys Hotel Landmark in Galt.
The papers have been finally signed and the Royal Bank now owns the old Central Hotel property on Main street in Galt, purchasing it from J. C. Caldwell of Hamilton. The bank is now having plans prepared for a handsome new building to replace the present landmark. Work on the new structure will commence in the spring.

Large Factory.
That 500 hands will be employed in by the Robins & Meyers Co., which has located in Brantford was the statement of General Manager Booth, who announced that the factory building would be 150 feet by 300 feet, the largest in the city. The building was to be completed by Jan. 1 next.

Warton Factory Burned.
Fire of unknown origin late Wednesday night totally destroyed the chair factory of the Canada Furniture Manufacturers' Company, Limited, with an approximate loss of \$75,000. When first discovered the blaze, which was located in an elevator shaft opposite the third story, did not appear to be serious. A safety strap in the shaft made fire-fighting difficult, and the flames soon spread beyond control. When they reached the finished varnish and oil were stored, it was apparent that the entire structure was doomed. Blazing oil shot flames many feet into the air, illuminating the sky to such an extent that the fire was seen thirty miles away. A steady rising wind threatened the destruction of many nearby buildings, but by strenuous efforts these were saved with practically no damage. The factory office and store room, located 25 feet from the factory, was razed to the ground. A quantity of lumber in the yard was also destroyed.
