

**An Act to establish the true location of the allowance
for Road between the Municipalities of Toronto Gore
and Etobicoke.**

WHEREAS the Reeve of the Township of the Gore of Toronto, in Preamble.
the County of Peel, acting on behalf of the Township Council,
hath by his petition to the Legislature represented, that serious difficul-
ties have heretofore existed as to the true location of the allowance for
5 Road between the Municipalities of Toronto Gore, in the County of Peel,
and that of Etobicoke, in the County of York, and that although it has
been in several cases decided in the Superior Courts of Law that the said
allowance is located as hereinafter described, and there is no case in
which any other decision has been given, but on the contrary there is
10 every reason to believe, for reasons assigned in the said Petition, that the
said decision was correct, yet, that for the avoidance of disputes, it is
desirable that the true location of the said allowance should be declared
by the Legislature: And whereas it appears that the allegations of the said
Petition are well founded: Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

15 I. The location of the allowance for Road between the said Municipal-
ities of Toronto Gore and Etobicoke, was and is adjoining to but Place of the

defined.
wholly on the eastern side of the original line known as the Indian or
thirty-six-mile line, and the said allowance is and shall be the public
highway between the said Municipalities.

20 II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
