BILL.

An Act further to amend the Act incorporating the President, Directors and Company of the Port Burwell Harbor.

WHEREAS it is expedient to allow the rates of Toll authorized by the Act passed in the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign intituled, "*An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Port Burwell Harbor Company*," to be taken by the said Company on certain articles to be raised in the discretion of the Company within certain limits ;

Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That from and after the passing of this Act it shall and may be lawful for the President, Directors and Company of Port Burwell Harbor, to impose, demand, receive, take, levy and collect (with the like powers as in the Act of Incorporation are provided for the recovery of Rates; or Tolls) on the following articles, passing out or from the said Harbor to a foreign port, rates not exceeding those hereinafter mentioned, and from time to time to reduce, alter or amend the same, that is to say: on every standard saw-log *six pence*; on every spar or mast, *seven shillings and six pence*; on all squared or hewed timber, *one shilling and six pence* per hundred feet, running measure; any thing in the Act hereinbefore cited or in any other Act or law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Company empowered to impose tolls to a certain amount on certain articles.
