## **BILL**.

An Act to fix the Mill Toll on Grain.

## WHEREAS it is expedient to fix the Mill Toll on Grain;

Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. From and after the passing of this Act the Mill Toll on all grain Toll fixed. delivered to Millers, to be cribbed and ground, shall be the fourteenth 5 part thereof.

11. The proprietor or occupant of any mill, or any person in his Penalty. employ who shall demand or receive a higher rate of mill toll on any grain delivered to him to be cribbed and ground, shall be liable to a fine of *Twenty Dollars* for each offence, and the said penalty shall be
10 recoverable in a summary manner before any Justice of the Peace for the District, and one-half thereof shall belong to the prosecutor, and the other half to the local municipality in which the offence is committed.

III. This Act shall apply to Lower Canada only.
