I intend ^{to} be in the Toronto convention on Monday the 17th. but unfortunately I have a case coming before the Supreme Court in Ottawa for that date and consequently I don't think it would be possible for me to be present at this rally .

I suppose you know that in the bye-election of the Quebec county which was just starting on when you were in Quebec, we were victorious . Our provincial candidate Ludger Bastien did win his election not only against the provincial government but also against Mr Lavigueur, member for the same county at the house of Commons . I think that this victory coming the day before your success in ~~the~~ Yale has a great importance .

I wish you every success in ~~Hastings~~ ^{the} young conservatives of Quebec are backing you to the limit .
