

two quarters, (viz, December and March), no Returns having been received by the Department for the two other quarters, (September, 1889, and June, 1890); and I beg to say that, under the regulations of the Department, regarding Indian schools, nothing can be paid for the past two quarters, (September and December, of this fiscal year) until the required Returns are received. The Indian Commissioner is however being written to in the matter.
