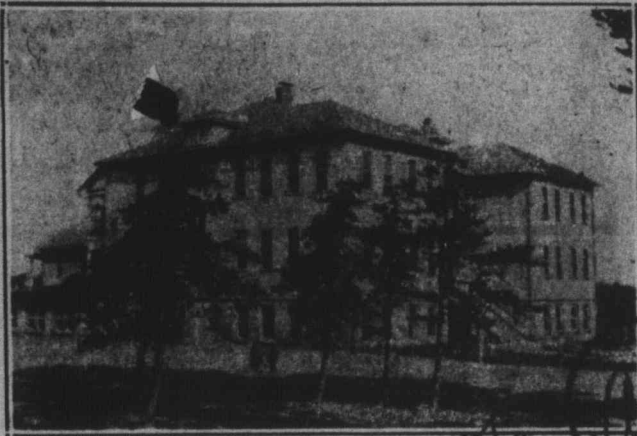

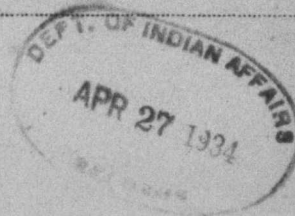

Dear Sir:-

For the past two or more years the Treaty payment for Alee. Pants. of Moose Factory Band No. 215 has been sent to me for him as he was a pupil of this school.

Since last payment he had to be sent to the Victoria Industrial School for Boys at Mimico Ontario. The question has arisen in my mind as to what action you wish to take in the future for this boy's payments. I have his ticket here. If you wish to send the payment annually in my care to be Banked for him until he returns or is placed in some place of employment by that school, or transfer the payment to him at that school, I shall be pleased to receive your instruction and carry it out.

The boy has written to me to know what is being done with it and I would like to give him a definite answer when I hear from you.
