Sir,-

With reference to the Minutes of a special meeting of the Council of the Mississaugas of the Credit which was held on the 19th ultimo and a copy of which you forwarded to the Department on the 20th ultimo, I beg to inform you as follows:

1. You may purchase 6 common chairs for the Council Chamber at a cost not exceeding \$5.00.
