
OTTAWA, 8th January, 1904-

Dear Mr. Emerson-

With further reference to your letter of the 24th of November last, enclosing a communication from Mr. Wm. M. Spence, respecting the Timber on an Indian Reserve in Hants Co., N.S., I beg to inform you that the smaller of the two Reserves, known as "Indian Brook", or Shubenacadie, is said to contain a small growth of hardwood intermingled with Spruce fit only for fire-wood and perhaps fence poles.

May I request you to ascertain from Mr. Spence whether he refers to this Reserve, or the larger one and to inform the Department accordingly.
