



Sir:-

The Department is sending you under separate cover, cheque No. 1863 for \$34.63 in payment of your account for drugs supplied to the Rev. J.H. Matthews for use of Indians at Hartley Bay. It is necessary that all accounts for drugs used within the Bella Coola Agency on behalf of Indians should be certified by the Indian Agent, Mr. Fougner, and therefore the account should have come to the Department through Mr. Fougner's office. It is being sent to him for his certificate. In future your accounts should be rendered to the Indian Agent.
