
Ottawa, December 6, 1917.

Madam,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo asking if the Department would consider the granting of the usual sum for prizes to be distributed at the end of the present quarter to the pupils of the No. 1 Walpole Island School.
